FUEL SURCHARGE

The following table lists the fuel surcharge to be applied given the applicable U.S. West Coast Average On-Highway Diesel Price as provided by the U.S. Department of Energy.

\$ 1.999 or less	0.0 %
At least \$ 2.000	1.0 %
At least \$ 2.600	2.0 %
At least \$ 3.200	3.0 %
When fuel price exceeds \$3.799, for each additional rise in fuel price of \$.60	Add an additional 1%

The Fuel Surcharge will apply to the total billed charges derived from the application of rates and charges in this Tariff and will be governed by the U.S. West Coast Average On-Highway Diesel Price as posted on the following Dept. of Energy web page, which is updated every Monday, approximately 1:00 P.M. (PST), except government holidays:

Exception: When a Fuel Surcharge applies, the minimum surcharge per shipment shall be \$1.00.

Note: Fractions of ½ cent or more will be rounded up to the next higher whole cent. Fractions of less than ½ cent will be round down to the next lower whole cent.

Should the fuel price go below \$2.000 per gallon, no Fuel Surcharge will apply. The Surcharge will remain in effect until a price decrease/increase in fuel price warrants a decrease/increase in the Surcharge.
